Programming a remote via the motor

- Remove the light/button cover (sectional/overhead motor) or the screw at the base of the motor (Door Master/Roller motor model only) to reveal the CODE button on the motor.
- Press and hold the CODE button on the motor until a small red dot appears in the bottom right corner of the motor display and let go of CODE immediately.
- 3. Immediately press and hold the button on the new remote once, let go of the remote button and press the same button a second time.
- 4. Test the remote.

Deleting all remotes from the motor

- Remove the light/button cover (sectional/overhead motor) or the screw at the base of the motor (Door Master/Roller motor model only) to reveal the CODE button on the motor.
- Press and hold the CODE button on the motor until a small red dot appears in the bottom right corner of the motor display and continue holding down the CODE button until the red dot goes out.
- 3. Test a working remote to ensure it is no longer working which will indicate that all remotes, including any lost or stolen remotes have been removed from the motor memory.
