Coding Instructions

- 1. Open the original working remote (may be located under the battery cover or you may need to remove the screws at the back of the remote).
 - Please note: If you do not have an original remote you will need to locate the DIP switches on the motor or receiver.
- 2. Open the new remote (may be located under the battery cover or you may need to remove the screws at the back of the remote).
- 3. Change the DIP switches in the new remote, by moving these up or down to match the switches in either your old remote or your motor.
- 4. Close the remotes and test.
